- Role playing conversations with legislators

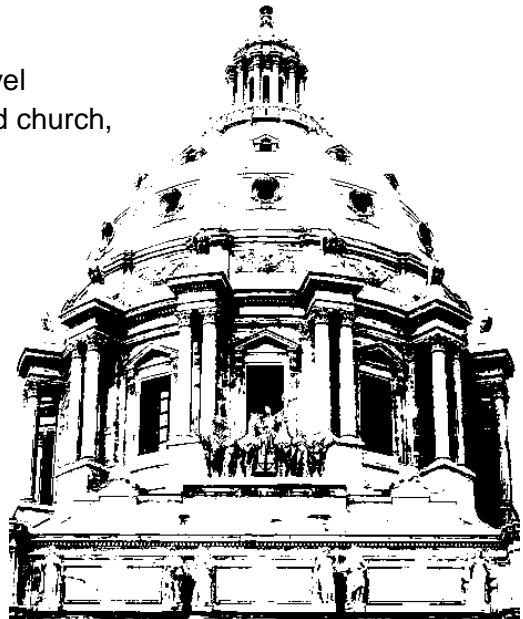
